What is LASACCO?

LASACCO is an acronym for Ladies Savings and Credit Cooperative. It is a SACCO registered with the Ministry of Women, SMEs and Development in Zimbabwe. It started operating in2016 and continues to offer savings and credit facilities to women running SMEs till now.

Why Does LASACCO Exist?

LASACCO's mission is to offer convenient, accessible and quick short term loans to women running small to medium sized enterprises (SMEs), and to help them grow to financial independence by providing a space for their savings, which will be earning interest on a monthly basis. Many other ancillary services have been built around these services, such as the monthly networking events which help members get to know each other and support each others' businesses, and the entrepreneurship training which happens online, and the magazine Fempreneurs Africa which showcases what women are able to achieve with the goal of encouraging them to start and run successful SMEs.

It was realized by the founders that women mostly do not control the assets that they use, and that even when they do have control, they need the assets for their day to day operations. Therefore, LASACCO was created to offer short term loans with 90 day tenures to women, without them needing to bring their security to our premises and leaving them there. Instead, LASACCO loans are guaranteed by fellow members using their savings within the group.

LASACCO exists to provide financial empowerment and literacy to its members so that they can make meaningful money decisions. In this manner, women can become wealthier and more powerful in their families and communities. An empowered woman contributes to an empowered and healthier nation and this is in line with Zimbabwe's SDG goals. Furthermore, when women are financially empowered, this reduces incidences of the spread of HIV/AIDS which is mainly spread through transactional sexual encounters.

What is the LASACCO Vision

To become an international women's bank, offering convenient, quick and affordable loans to women running SMEs across Africa.

What Are The Rights and Obligations of Members of LASACCO?

The LASACCO monthly events enable you to meet more like-minded women and promote your business through word of mouth (which has been proven to be the best form of advertising). You also get to be part of a WhatsApp group for networking and ideas pollination purposes too.
- Showcasing Through our magazine Fempreneurs Africa, members are able to showcase their businesses and achievements to the whole world. Your business can be profiled and advertised to reach hundreds of thousands of readers.
- Exhibitions Quarterly we hold events where members can bring their products and share them with our visitors. This can be online when there are

lockdowns or physically when the laws allow it. Meeting new customers this way is a great way to grow your business

- Training LASACCO uses internationally recognized material to train its members on entrepreneurship, from the stage where they start conceptualizing their business idea, to the launch or start up phase, through improving systems and finally expanding the business to its intended size.
- Business Mentorship Access our database of acclaimed business mentors to help you on a one-on-one basis through all the stages of running a business. We understand that the process can be bewildering and lonely, and are there to hold your hand through it all, so that you come out on the other side happy and successful!
